The school has been ranked in the **Top Ten Leaders of North Delhi Schools by Times of India and 32nd in the State by Education World India**.

The Orientation Programme for class I will be held on 25th March 2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 11:00-12:00 a.m. in the Primary Wing (Ph-I). The Orientation Programme will acquaint you with the norms of the school and provide an opportunity to interact with the teachers. For transport enquiries, you may contact Ms. Madhu Masson and Ms. Poonam Verma (Transport incharges) at the **Primary Wing Reception on the Orientation Day.**
- **Students promoted to Class I must report to Primary Wing (Phase I) on 27th March 2017 before 8:10 in summer uniform.**
- Students promoted to **Class VII must report to Senior Wing, Phase III on 28th March 2017 before 7:55 a.m.** For transport queries, please contact **Ms. Saroj Gulati and Ms. Anshuman Rishi on 25 March 2017 at Senior Wing from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.**
- Regular P.T.Ms are held for the holistic development of the child's personality and provide you updates of the child's progress. **The schedule of PTMs and other details are clearly mentioned in the School Almanac.** Please attend all parent workshops, orientations and PTMs.
- Please use the School Almanac to communicate with the school and refer to it for other details. Please read it carefully before signing the declaration form. **Ensure that your ward carries the Almanac to school every day.**
- The school transport is the safest mode of transportation and has adequate coverage area to facilitate student transportation.
- **In case your ward is travelling to school through private conveyance, please ensure that the transport fulfills all safety and security norms.**
- Please be very particular that it is not overcrowded, and is adequately manned by a licensed driver and helper.
- Ensure that the transporter uses language suitable for the tender ears of the young children.
- Verify the antecedents of the driver and maintain a record with his photo ID and address.
- **Ensure that the transport drops your ward to school not before 7:30 a.m. at Senior Wing, 7:45 a.m. at Primary Wing and 8:10 a.m. at Nursery Wing.**

- Ensure that your ward is picked up soon after school closes and is not left to move around after school hours.
- Please tell the van driver to drop and pick up the child from the school gate. Most vans park far away and children have to walk to school from that distance and at times cross the road too.
- **The school maintains no connection with any private transporter whatsoever. The use of private conveyance is totally at your discretion. The school may not be held responsible for any untoward incident occurring outside the school premises or in the private conveyance.**
